


**3.** Narrow flags. Create a narrow gap with two flags. The top of the flags must be higher than the pony's ears. It should look and feel like a squeeze. Lead your pony through safely.



**4.** Weave. Pony <u>and</u> handler to weave at walk through five cones together.








**2. Tarpaulin.** Pony and handler to walk over tarpaulin <u>together</u>.

**5. Ball.** Walk 3m (10ft) with your pony, handler kicking a ball in front of him. Maintain loose lead rope throughout. Does not need to be in a straight line. Ball can be any size.





FINISH

**1.** Curtain. Handler to pass through curtain with pony safely at walk.

**START**
